



Admission Requirements for New First-Time Freshmen

Northeastern Illinois University utilizes an **Admission Decision Score (ADS)** to determine admission for new first-time freshmen. The minimum admission requirements are as follows:

ADS range 550 – 648 Admission to Student Success Programs

ADS range 648 and up General Admission

The **Admission Decision Score (ADS)** is calculated using the formula:

$$(ACT\ Composite)(10) + (Cum\ HS\ GPA)(200) = ADS$$

If you've taken the **SAT**, you can use the concordance table below to determine your equivalent **ACT Composite Score** for use in the formula above.
