Those seeking to utilize federal VA benefits must be taking courses that count towards their respective degree. Typically, students-at-large are not eligible for federal VA benefits. Meet with Veterans Services to discuss exceptions to this regulation. Federal benefits will not cover any online classes below the 100 level. All courses below the 100 level must be taken in the classroom. Typically, repeat courses will not be paid for by federal VA benefits. Meet with Veterans Services to review your circumstances. If you need to add and drop another course, always do so in the same day. Dropping a class and waiting a day or more to register for another class will result in a decreased payment by the VA. And you will be responsible for any remaining balance.

	Before withdrawing from any course, contact Veterans Services to discuss how it may affect your funding or create a debt to the VA or NEIU. As the student, you will be held accountable for debt caused by course withdrawal.						
	Chapter 33 recipients must pursue at least 7 credits as an undergraduate and at least 5 credits as a graduate to qualify for a housing stipend. Any pursuit below 12 credits (undergrad) or 9 credits (grad) will result in a prorated housing allowance, based on the rate of pursuit.
