The School Leadership concentration develops competencies related to effective leadership, educational management practices and staff development. All courses for the School Leadership concentration are offered in Lake County. By taking 2 courses each fall, spring and summer, students can complete the master's degree and obtain an Illinois Type 75 Administrative Certificate within 2 years.

The Higher Education Concentration stresses an understanding of procedures, structures and programs required for the development and support higher education.

## ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS:

- Bachelor's degree
- Minimum 2.75 G.P.A. on a 4.0 scale
- Two letters of recommendation
- Graduate Record Examination (GRE) for candidates without a master's degree
- Minimum of 2 years of full-time teaching experience

Students at Large (SAL):

- Bachelor's degree
- [Admission as a SAL should be done through the Admissions & Records Office (773/442-4000) at least two months prior to the term. Courses taken by a SAL are subject to acceptance by the Graduate College for use in a degree program.]

## COST:
