

The Office of Undergraduate Admissions supports the admissions and recruitment of freshman and transfer students to Northeastern Illinois University. As a first point of contact for most students, admissions counselors/recruiters assist students with understanding the admissions process and completing their applications to the university.

Important Information

Admissions Operations is responsible for processing all applications and documents for undergraduate admission applicants (freshmen, transfer, readmit, 2nd bachelor's and Undergraduate Student-at-Large), making admission decisions, admission decision correspondence, initial transfer credit evaluation (including AP, CLEP), updates, and transfer credit re-evaluation.

Graduate Admissions is responsible for the recruitment and processing of all graduate applications (master's degree, certificate/endorsement/licensure, and Graduate Student-at-Large), making admission decisions (in conjunction with academic departments), and admission decision correspondence.

Financial Aid, Scholarships & Student Employment

Important Information

Financial Aid, Scholarships & Student Employment has moved its entire operation remote – from document imaging and virtual advising to dataload exchanges between governmental agencies. Here are some things you should know to make your transition to Northeastern Illinois University successful:

- 1) Apply for financial aid via FAFSA or RISE Act Alternative Application beginning October 1
- 2) Options for Submitting Verification Documents to the Financial Aid Office
 - (Preferred method) Download the fillable Adobe PDF from either NEIUport > My Financial Aid or neiu.edu/financial-aid. Complete and email to financial-aid@neiu.edu.
 - Email and attach clear picture/image to financial-aid@neiu.edu.
 - Fax documents to (773) 442-5040. These are scanned weekly and routed to document imaging.
- 3) Schedule a virtual appointment with Financial Aid at neiu.edu/aidappointment.
- 4) Email the Financial Aid Office at financial-aid@neiu.edu
 - Use the email address above and one of the items below as the subject line. Do not forget to include your NEIU ID Number in the email.
 - Request virtual advising appointment
 - Request status of 2021 financial aid status
 - Request The Nest financial approval
 - Anticipated scholarship
 - Anticipated private loan
 - Options available for prior balances

Important Information

The Registrar's Office supports students with registration and their academic record, specifically assisting with the following:

- Creating a Schedule of Classes
- Registering for classes
- Issuing enrollment and degree verification letters and documents
- Issuing official academic transcripts
- Processing Major/Minor Declaration forms
- Processing grades
- Updating a student's legal name or chosen first name
- Updating address and other demographic information
- Processing applications for graduation, and issuing diplomas

The Registrar's Office also assists students in protecting the privacy of their education records by upholding the Family Educational Rights and Privacy Act (FERPA). FERPA allows students to 1) control the release of directory information, as defined by law, and 2) allows for the student to have individuals advocating on a student's behalf by having the student designate individuals who can have access to information about the student. Student Payment Services

Important Information

Student Payment Services can:

- answer students' questions about tuition and fees charged to their student accounts
- explain the payment deadlines, how payment can occur, the refund process, and how adding/dropping/ withdrawing classes can affect account balances
- assist students with establishing payment plans for account balances

Please note:

- Currently, staff are in the office approximately once each week, but at this time cannot meet with students for face-to-face transactions.
- If you currently have an accounts receivable hold on your student record, please email us directly to discuss options for payment or removing this hold.
- If you need help establishing a payment plan, please contact us at our office email. NEIU offers monthly payment plans for students.
- Information about mandatory fees is available at neiu.edu/fees.
- Student refunds are generally processed about the fourth week of each semester. Students are strongly encouraged to set up an electronic refund account in NEIUport in order to receive refunds electronically.

Please understand that we cannot approve transcript requests for students who currently have a past due student account balance.
